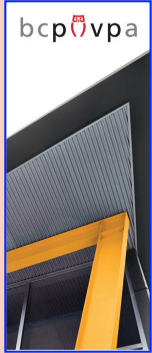

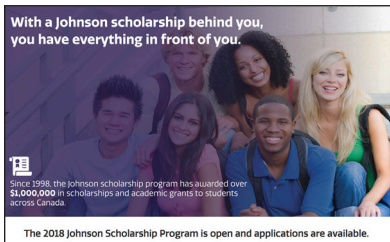


Premier's Awards for Excellence in Education
